RULES FOR THE II BAROQUE VIOLIN COMPETITION "JOSE HERRANDO"

DATE AND LOCATION

The competition will take place in the Teatro Municipal Mónaco of Onda on November 23rd and 24th, 2020.

REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must have a degree in higher education or be in their final years of study. There is no age limit.

ROUNDS

The competition comprises two rounds. A maximum of 5 violinists will be selected for the final round.

- First Round – November 23rd
Candidates must present a 15-20 minutes program including:
 - A Spanish sonata for violin and continuo (e.g. Francisco Manalt, Juan de Ledesma, José Herrando, Juan Oliver Astorga, etc.).
 - At least 2 contrasting movements for solo violin excluding J.S. Bach (e.g. Telemann, Pisendel, Vilmayr, Matteis or Tartini).
- Final Round – November 24th
Candidates selected for the final round must present a half-hour program including:
 - 2 movements from J.S. Bach's solo sonatas.
 - 2 movements from a sonata for violin and continuo composed before 1750 to be chosen by the candidate.
 - Sonata "Jardín de Aranjuez" or one of José Herrando's duets for two violins. In case of choosing a duo, the candidate must bring an accompanist.

Interpretation without second violin will be not penalised, but it is not recommended. For the duets, scores from Snakewood Editions can be used at candidate's request.

INSTRUMENTS REQUIREMENTS

Participants must have an instrument that is suitable for historical performance with gut strings and a baroque bow. A415 tuning must be used.

ACCOMPANIMENT

The organization will provide harpsichord accompaniment upon request. An A415 tuned harpsichord will be available.

The organization will provide transportation from train stations near Onda and accommodation for those who need it.

REGISTRATION

The registration deadline is October 19th and candidates will be accepted in order of registration. The registration fee of € 30 must be paid before November 10th. Once the registration period has closed, a detailed schedule will be sent to each participant.
